WHAT DOES HUSTISFORD STATE BANK DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?

Why?	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires that we tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.
What?	<p>The types of personal information that we collect and share depends on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Account balances and transaction history • Social Security number • Payment history • Account transactions • Checking Account information <p>When you are <i>no longer</i> our customer, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.</p>
How?	All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information; the reasons Hustisford State Bank chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

What We Do	
How does Hustisford State Bank protect my personal information?	To protect your personal financial information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer security safeguards and secured files and buildings.
How does Hustisford State Bank collect my personal information?	<p>We collect your personal information, for example, when you:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Apply for a loan ● Open an account ● Use your credit or debit card ● Make deposits or withdrawals from your account ● Provide account information <p>We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates, or other companies.</p>
Why can't I limit all sharing?	<p>Federal law gives you the right to limit only:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes – information about your credit worthiness. ● Affiliates from using your information to market to you. ● Sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you. <p>State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.</p>
Definitions	
Affiliates	<p>Companies related to common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● <i>Our affiliates include our Holding Company- Hustisford Community Bancorp.</i>
Nonaffiliates	<p>Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● <i>Hustisford State Bank does not share with nonaffiliates so they can market to you.</i>
Joint Marketing	<p>A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● <i>Hustisford State Bank doesn't jointly market.</i>
